



SCDC Youth Camper Checklist

We're so excited that you'll be joining us for our SCDC Youth Camp! We want to make sure you have everything you need to have a great experience. Here are the steps you can take to make sure you are prepared.

PACK YOUR BAGS LIKE A PRO

Make sure you pack the right stuff for an exceptional weekend at Camp. Keep track of personal items. To help recover lost items, put your name on all bags and belongings.

We ask that you help us in the choices of clothing you bring to Camp. Campers should have enough clothing to last the duration of their stay. Campers should bring clothing that can get wet, dirty, and muddy without concern.

All clothing should be keeping with our Apostolic values. All phrases/graphics/logos should be in good taste. To avoid distractions, we ask that you not wear sports team apparel.

We reserve the right to prohibit the wearing of any clothing the Camp Pastor and Director deem inappropriate.

Possession of drugs, drug paraphernalia, tobacco, or alcohol products is grounds for immediate dismissal from Camp.

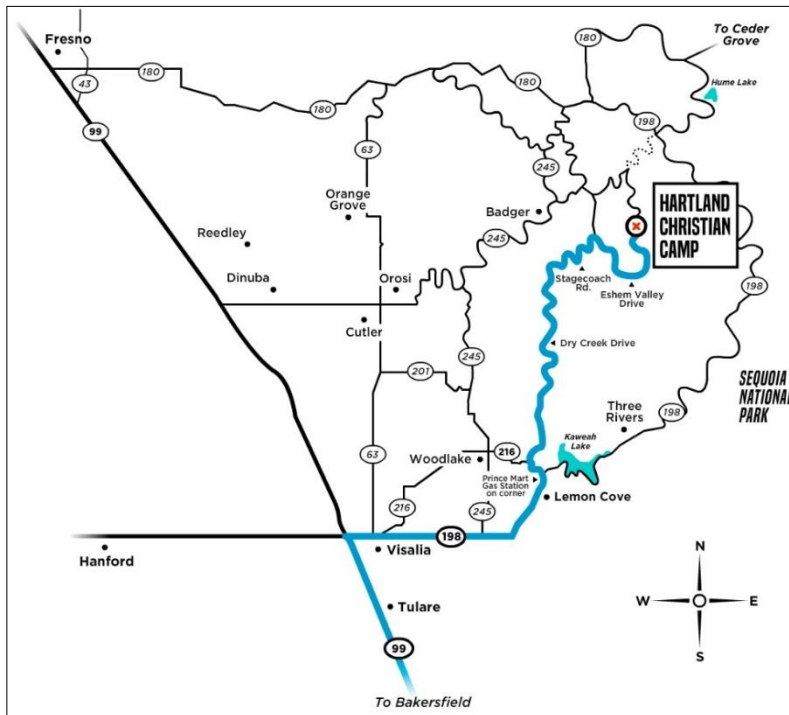

BRINGING FOOD TO CAMP

Hartland takes care in providing balanced meals with various options for breakfast, lunch and dinner. **We urge all campers to take advantage of the food provided at camp.** However, the camp cannot prepare individual meals for the campers, so we recommend that parents send meals and snacks in the event that your camper has food allergies/preferences that would prohibit them from eating camp food.

All snacks must be stored in air-tight containers, such as a zip-lock bag. Do not bring a large container of candy or other sweets. Bottled water only.

GETTING TO CAMP



From Visalia (recommended route):

1. Go east on Hwy 198 to Lemon Cove **19.0 mi.**
**DO NOT TURN AT LOVERS LANE, 216 EXIT. PROCEED TO TOWN OF LEMON COVE.*
2. Turn left at Hwy 216 (Prince Mart gas station on corner) **0.5 miles.**
3. Turn right on Dry Creek Road (J21) **16.0 mi.**
4. Turn right at the "Y" onto Stagecoach Rd **2.4 mi.**
5. Turn right onto Eshom Valley Drive **7.0 miles.**

CHECK-IN / REGISTRATION 3:00 pm on Thursday, August 6th (2:00 PM for Staff)

All campers must bring the following forms:

- **Signed Registration Form** – signed by Camper (Parent, if under 18) & Pastor
- **Signed Hartland Waiver** – signed by Camper (and Parent, if under 18)
- **All Staff** must turn in a Staff Registration form (must be signed by your Pastor as well)
